About COVID-19 vaccination for children accompanied by someone other than legal guardian

When a child aged between 12 and 15 years get vaccinated, in principle, the child must be **accompanied by a parent/ legal guardian**. But if the legal guardian is unable to accompany the child for some reason, a relative who is familiar with the child's health condition may accompany the child for vaccination.

However, if the child is accompanied by someone other than parent/ legal guardian, a "Power of Attorney" is required. Please fill out the required items of the above "Power of Attorney for COVID-19 Vaccination" (Shingata Korona wakuchin Sesshu ni Okeru Douhan Ininjyou), and bring it along to the vaccination site.

Please note that a "Power of Attorney" is required even if the child is accompanied by a relative (grandparents, etc.) who lives with you.
