Start with what you can do, little by little

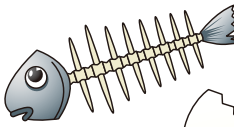
Drain kitchen garbage before disposing of it as combustible waste!

Fallen leaves, cut grass



Cut branches of garden trees
(each 50 cm or less in length)

Dispose of fallen leaves, cut grass, cut leaves, and cut tree branches (each 50 cm or less in length and 5 cm or less in diameter) on the last collection day of the week (e.g., Thursday for Monday and Thursday collection areas, Friday for Tuesday and Friday collection areas).

For infection prevention

Put used masks, tissue paper, gloves, etc. in a plastic bag, remove the air inside, and tie the mouth.



Crushable garbage

- Mattress pads
- Cooler boxes
- Suitcases
- Carpets
- Umbrellas
- Child car seats
- Strollers

Bulk refuse

Glass and ceramics

- Ashtrays, aquariums and other glass objects
- Ceramics and glass tableware
- Cosmetic bottles

Any items that need to be collected via the city's paid door-to-door bulk refuse collection service are not accepted at garbage collection points. (Please see reverse side for more information.)

Items NOT collected at garbage collection points

● Fireproof safes ● Handcarts ● Electric organs ● Organs etc.

Bring these directly to the Yokkaichi City Clean Center.

Items NOT collected/handled by the City

- Motorized bicycles/mopeds
- Motorcycles
- Pesticides and other toxic items
- Syringes and hypodermic needles
- Tires

- Oils (kerosene, gasoline, etc.)
- Items under the Act on Recycling of Specified Kinds of Home Appliances
- Propane gas cylinders
- Fire extinguishers
- Paints, etc.

You cannot discard these at garbage collection points. Nor can they be brought directly to the Yokkaichi City Clean Center or to the Yokkaichi City Kusu Sanitation Center.

Any refuse generated by a business must NOT be discarded at the garbage collection point.

Prohibited!

Never mix waste containing mercury (mercury thermometers, mercury sphygmomanometers, etc.) with combustible or crushable garbage!

If mercury enters an incinerator, it will cause a severe operational failure.

Do NOT put spray cans and lighters in the same waste bag.
