

Persons with underlying condition

1. Persons who are outpatient / hospitalized due to the following illnesses and conditions

- Chronic respiratory disease
- Chronic heart disease (including hypertension)
- Chronic kidney disease
- Chronic liver disease
- Diabetes being treated with insulin or oral medication or diabetes with complications
- Blood pressure disease (except for iron-deficiency anemia)
- Diseases that affect the immune system (including malignant tumors under treatment)
- Receiving treatments that reduce immune function, such as steroids
- Neurological and neuromuscular diseases associated with immune disorders
- Weakened physical function due to neurological or neuromuscular diseases (respiratory disorders, etc.)
- Chromosomal abnormality
- Severe mental and physical disability (severe mental disability and severe physical disability)
- Sleep apnea syndrome
- Severe mental illness (hospitalized for the treatment of mental illness, holder of Mental disability booklet (*seishin shougai sha hoken fukushi techou*), or apply to "severe and continued" patient in independence support facility medical care (psychiatric outpatient care)) and Intellectual disability (holder of Intellectual disability booklet (*ryouiku techou*))

2. People with a BMI of 30 or higher
